



Title: Additional Site-Study Funding for Bus Shelters

Whereas, Dunn County Transit has received a grant for implementing bus shelter along their bus routes;

Whereas, there are plans for three sites on the Stout Route to receive shelters including the library which will have two shelters, the clocktower plaza, and the red cedar stops;

Whereas, Dunn County Transit can only use \$4,000 of the grant money to perform site studies for the bus shelters and this will not be enough to conduct these studies at all the proposed locations;

Whereas, Dunn County Transit is asking if \$1,000 from the Alternative Transportation segregated fee can be used to pay for the site studies that will be done for the bus shelters on the Stout Route;

Whereas, the Sustainability Council has discussed and passed this recommendation for allocation;

Be it therefore resolved, we, the U.S.S. of the S.S.A. approve the allocation of \$1,000 from the Alternative Transportation segregated fee to Dunn County Transit for the site studies that will be done for the bus shelter locations on the Stout Route.
