**Title:** Motion to Recommend Student Technology Fee One-Time Funding for Disability Services

**Whereas,** the SSA Student Information Technology Committee (SITC) has received and reviewed a Student Technology Fee (STF) request from Disability Services for the 2020-2021 fiscal year;

*Whereas,* Disability Services requested a total of \$26,700 in STF funding including \$8,500 for an AIM Data Management System, \$3,000 for 2 FM Microphone Systems, \$10,800 for a Kurzweil 3000 Site-License, and \$4,400 for 20 Smart Pens;

Whereas, SITC has determined that the AIM Data Management software did not meet the requirements for SITC as it is on ongoing cost and is operational in nature;

*Whereas,* The Kurzweil 3000 Site License was able to use remaining funds from the current 19-20 fiscal year in order to be funded;

Whereas, SITC has determined the Wireless FM System is an acceptable use of STF dollars and recommends the approval of 1 FM system for the cost of \$1,500;

**Whereas,** SITC has determined the Smart Notetaking Pens is an acceptable use of STF dollars and recommends the one-time approval of 5 Smart Notetaking Pens for the cost of \$1,100;

Whereas, the SITC bylaws state that "Allocations not categorized as base costs will not be allowed to be funded for more than one (1) fiscal year.";

**Be it therefore resolved,** the U.S.S of the S.S.A recommends to the Chancellor that \$2,600 in one-time funding from the Student Technology Fee should be used for 1 FM microphone system and 5 Smart notetaking pens for the 20-21 fiscal year.

**Be it further resolved,** A memo to the Chancellor shall be written by the Director of Information Technology and the Chief Information Officer in order to provide a formal request to the Chancellor for the STF allocation.

**Be it further resolved,** this motion be distributed to UW-Stout Chief Information Officer Sue Traxler, and SSA Director of Information Technology Riley Kangas.
