Title: Compensation for University Court Justices

2 3 Whereas, the judicial branch serves an essential part of the Stout Student Association's mission, by settling cases and controversies surrounding governing documents as well as 4 ensuring student organizations are complying with the Student Organizational Code of 5 Conduct: 6 7 Whereas, it can often be difficult to find students who are able to dedicate the time required 8 9 to serve as a University Court Justice; 10 11 Be it therefore resolved, we, the U.S.S. of the S.S.A. authorize the following pay scale for University Court justices for the duration of the 51st Congress in the form of SSA Leadership 12 Scholarships, similar to the current compensation provided to SSA Executives, Directors, 13 14 and Senators: 15 16 **Chief Justice** \$750 17 \$350 Vice Chief Justice 18 Associate Justice \$200 19 20 Be it further resolved, the pay scale above shall be prorated for those who do not hold the 21 position for the full academic year, in a manner similar to the way SSA Leadership 22 23 Scholarships are already prorated for SSA Executives, Directors, and Senators. 24
